Local bus connections to villages need improvement



The Renfrewshire Liberal Democrats are demanding the Government steps up to improve local bus services.

With cuts to bus services across Renfrewshire particularly impacting villages, the Scottish Governments need to offer more funding for local government to be able to support services for transport routes.

Liberal Democrat campaigner Grant Toghill said, "For many people buses are a key lifeline for travel, even more so in villages such as Bridge of Weir. Cuts to bus services are pushing us backwards when we need more routes not less. "SNP claim victory through giving more powers to councils, but with no funding to back it this is just an empty promise.

"The Scottish Government need to put money into local government, so they can help support services to connect our villages.

"This is also crucial if we want to tackle the climate emergency by giving reliable options that residents will want to use.

"Bus routes need to get investment and the SNP and Green Scottish Government don't seem to be interested."

Renfrewshire Liberal Democrats are calling for urgent action from the Scottish Government to improve access to local dentists.

Shocking new figures show patients are having to wait up to **112 WEEKS** to get the treatment they need across the Greater Glasgow and Clyde health board.

Grant Toghill said: "Dentistry in Renfrewshire is struggling and that is impacting people's lives.

"Waiting times have shot up and the number of dentists performing NHS treatment have fallen. This is not just happening locally but across Scotland.



"The SNP are so obsessed with other priorities that they are failing to focus on the day-to-day issues of people in areas like Renfrewshire.

"We are calling for the government to rewrite the NHS Recovery Plan to properly recognise dentists and to reform funding structures to enable many more people to be seen and drive down wait times."

Grant Toghill said, "This is absolutely disgusting. Our rivers should be protected and places like Erskine beach should not be at risk of being polluted.

"At the moment in England almost every sewage overflow is monitored but in Scotland it's only a small fraction. The new Environment Secretary needs to record and publish all sewage discharges so we get a true picture.

"Scottish Lib Dems are campaigning for an acceleration of measures to upgrade Scotland's Victorian sewage systems and prevent almost 19,000 Olympic pools worth of sewage from flowing into our rivers and onto our beaches."
